

JULY 2025 CULTURAL MEETING

Members at the July Cultural Meeting welcomed two regular visitors to The Orchid House, Brian Heath and his lovely lady Lyn. Brian was our Guest Speaker for the day, imparting his knowledge on Encyclias to the group and a few well received jokes along the way, whilst Lyn looked after plant sales. Members always seem to enjoy adding to their collections whenever possible. There will also be lots on offer at the myriad of shows around the region over the next few months, including our own Spring Show on the 10th and 11th October.

Encyclias, whilst being known for around 250 years in Mexico, Florida and the Caribbean, are still being found in Cuba up to 1200 metres. In recent times, some Epidendrums have been reclassified as Encyclias. *Enc. tempensis* like our *Den. bigibbum (Cooktown orchid)* likes to be kept very dry winter, while *Enc. alata* 'the winged Enyclia' from Central America likes cooler temperatures and doesn't like drying out. Some Encyclias, known for their bulbous growth and long thin leaves, like growing on mounts and the flower spikes can last for around 2 months. *Enc. cordigera* 'the Queen of the genus' is known for its rich purple colour.



If you're looking for something new and different, why not give this genus a try. You're sure to be rewarded.


